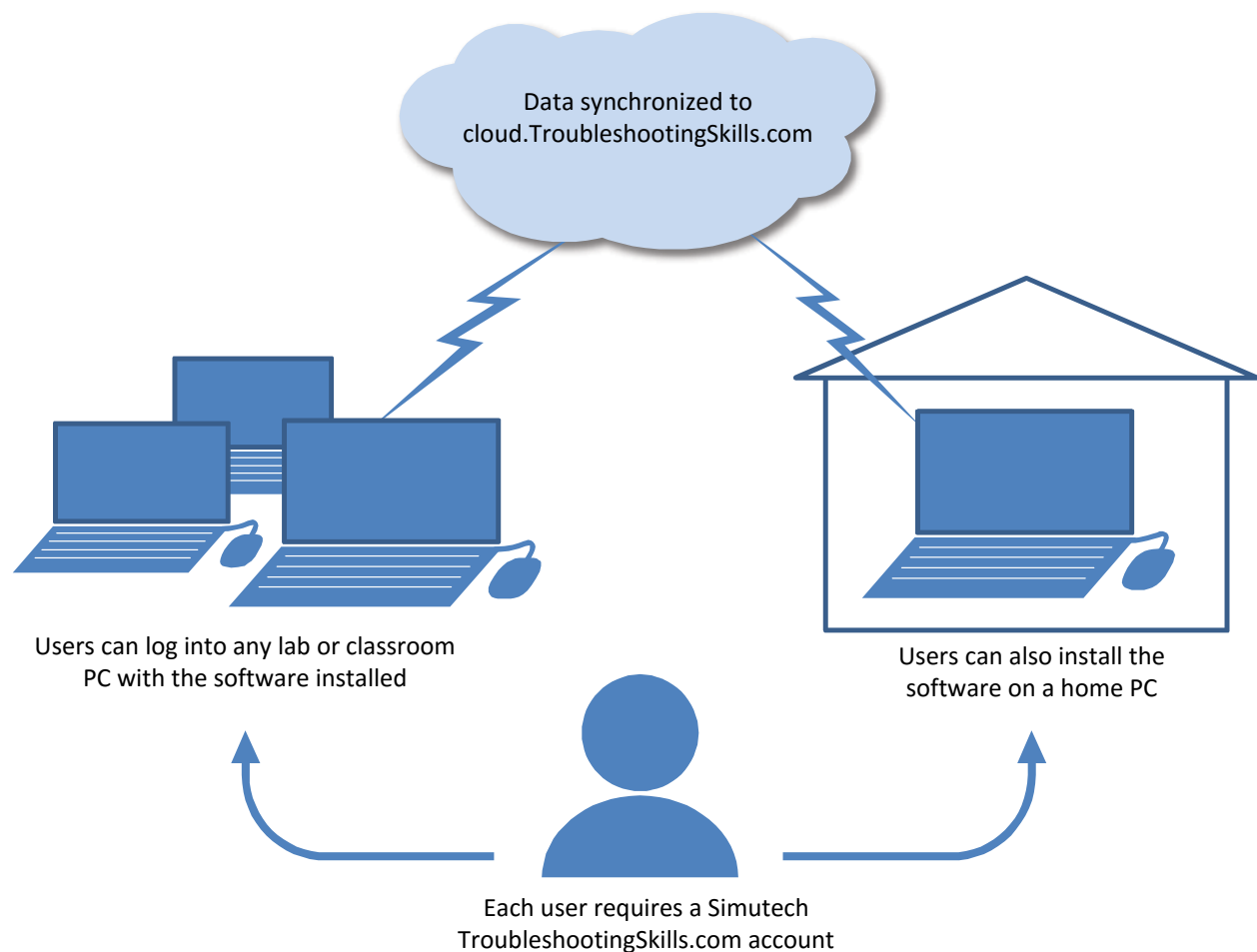

Overview

The Troubleshooting Skills Training System is a series of software programs from Simutech Multimedia Inc. designed to teach effective troubleshooting skills. Each program contains electrical system simulations providing a rich hands-on learning experience.

The Transit Edition enables users to access the software virtually anywhere there is a Windows PC and an internet connection. The software programs can be installed on multiple computers, with progress and results stored on the internet. This allows users to start on one computer, and then later continue from another computer from where they left off.



The system uses **licenses** to keep track of which programs a user has access to. Licenses are available for individual programs as well as groups of programs called bundles. Each user requires their own unique license.

System Requirements for 4.8

- Windows 7 SP1 / 8.1 / 10
- Video Resolution of 1024 x 768 or greater
- Sound Card
- Mouse

NOTE: *The software must be installed on each PC that it will be used from.
Server or network installations are not supported.*

Bandwidth Requirements

Initially the programs need to be installed on the PC where it will be used. Typical program downloads are between 30MB and 60MB. Once the programs are installed, only the user progress data is transmitted through the internet. The amount of this data is extremely small, typically in the area of 10KB to 20KB when signing in and signing out of the program.

The Simutech Course manager software will use more bandwidth than the program but the amount will depend on the number of users, and types and number of reports generated.
